

Coffee Shop - Lesson 2

Recipe Adjustments



It is important to make sure you have enough supplies to make several servings (cups) of coffee without having to change your special recipe:

If you have 25 units (of cups) and your recipe calls for 1 unit per serving, how many servings can you make?

If you have 40 tsp (teaspoons) of Coffee grounds and your recipe calls for 2 tsp per serving, how many servings can you make?

If you have 20 cups of Milk and your recipe calls for 0.2 cups per serving, how many servings can you make?

If you have 20 tsp of Sugar and your recipe calls for 2 tsp of sugar per serving, how many servings can you make?

Here is a great recipe for 1 serving of Coffee:

Cups	1 unit
Coffee	2 tsp
Milk	0.4 cups
Sugar	3 tsp

Your inventory of supplies is:

Cups	25 unit
Coffee	45 tsp
Milk	8 cups
Sugar	70 tsp

What is the maximum amount of servings you can make?
